Mental Health Support:

At present, Mental Health Support Teams are operating at a reduced capacity whilst preparing for a new offer which is due to be launched in 2022. The support teams will begin to offer support for pupils aged between 5-18 with mild to moderate mental health needs. This will include 1-1 sessions, group sessions and assemblies. Eventually, more will be offered as the service develops including parent/carer workshops, out of term time sessions and staff training.

- •Sunday 28th March, 2021 and
- •Monday 12th April, 2021 (prior to the return back to school on the Tuesday).
